Michael McCarthy launched his career in the portable sanitation industry in 1972 with Mr. John, Inc., located in Keasbey, NJ. He started working in the warehouse repairing wooden portable toilets, and under the guidance of owner and mentor Mort Weiner, Michael moved up the ranks to become Vice President. In 1985 he took advantage of an opportunity to purchase the Pittsburgh division of Mr. John, and relocated to Western PA. As managing partner Michael took the reins of a 12 employee company, with assets that included 800 portable restrooms and 6 trucks. Through hard work, timely acquisitions, and the help of a great team, the business grew


to 60 employees, 4000 portable restrooms, 300 mobile office trailers, 55 company vehicles, and a wastewater & septic division.
